

CHAMPAIGN COUNTY MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM (MDT):

The MDT consists of the Ford and Champaign County States Attorney's Office, CA,C staff DCFS, 15 law enforcement agencies, (including the FBI and homeland security), CARLE (medical), and 4 local mental health professionals.

- 17 MDT Members attended "Medical Neglect in child abuse" training conducted by Dr. Buetow
- All CAC members got vaccinated against COVID-19






Our Mission:
