COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2015-05

MISDEMEANOR SECOND CHANCE PROGRAM

The Champaign County State's Attorney's Office (CCSAO) has created the Misdemeanor Second Chance Program (MSCP) which provides first-time, non-violent criminal defendants an opportunity to avoid a criminal conviction. Defendants who are accepted into the MSCP:

- (1) will be monitored by Champaign County Court Services staff;
- (2) will be required to agree to the written conditions of the program, including but not limited to completion of public service work, on line education programs, payment of restitution, if any, and payment of an MSCP fee as outlined below:
- (3) and will have their charge dismissed upon the successful performance of the program.

Defendants who apply and are accepted into the MSCP are Ordered to pay actual restitution (if any) and the following fees and costs made payable to the Champaign County Circuit Clerk:

(1) Misdemeanor Second Chance Program fee

a. Class A misdemeanor: \$ 100.00

b. Class B misdemeanor: \$ 75.00

c. Class C misdemeanor: \$50.00

IT IS ORDERED, that the Champaign County Circuit Clerk shall accept fees and restitution from the defendants for the MSCP and shall distribute the fees and restitution as follows:

- (1) The Misdemeanor Second Chance Program fee shall be distributed in full to the general corporate fund for Champaign County;
- (2) Restitution, if any, shall be distributed in full to the victim as set forth in the agreement of conditions entered into by the defendant and the CCSAO.
- (3) The Court Orders that any bond in this case will be applied to the MSCP fees as well as any restitution, costs or fees.
