

## RECYCLE Yardwaste

**trees, shrubs, bulk wood, leaves, grass clippings, brush, sod, woodchips, clean sod**

The **Landscape Recycling Center (LRC)** is a not-for-profit facility operated by the City of Urbana on behalf of the City of Urbana, the City of Champaign and Champaign County. The LRC is the only Illinois EPA permitted landscape recycling center in Champaign County.

Materials accepted by the LRC include: trees, shrubs, bulkwood, leaves, grass clippings, brush, plant cuttings, sod, woodchips, and clean soil.

The LRC sells processed materials (such as fertile mulch and composts) to both the public and to private firms.

**Winter Hours** (December 20, 2010 through March 4, 2011)

OPEN - 8:00am - 4:00pm, Monday - Friday

CLOSED - Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays

**Summer Hours** (March 7, 2011 through December 17, 2011)

OPEN - 8:00am - 4:00pm, Monday - Saturday

CLOSED - Sundays and Holidays

### **LRC Acceptable Materials:**

- Sod
- Wood Chips
- Clean Soil
- Tree Shrub Material
- Leaves and Grass Clippings
- Paper Bags for lawn and leaf refuse
- Brush and Plant Cuttings (diameter 6 in. or less, length 8 ft. or less)
- Bulkwood (limbs cut into 3 ft. or less lengths and separated from other yard waste)

### **LRC Unacceptable Materials:**

- Refuse or debris
- Plastic bags
- Wood pallets
- Lumber or railroad ties
- Tree stumps or root wads
- Animal and/or food wastes
- Concrete riprap or rock
- Flocked Christmas trees
