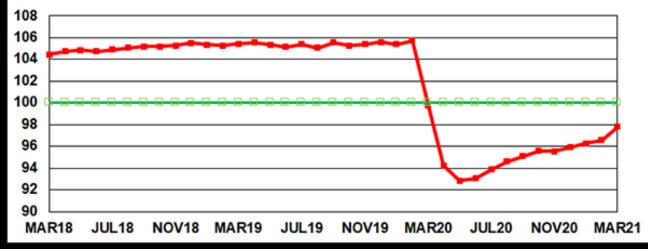

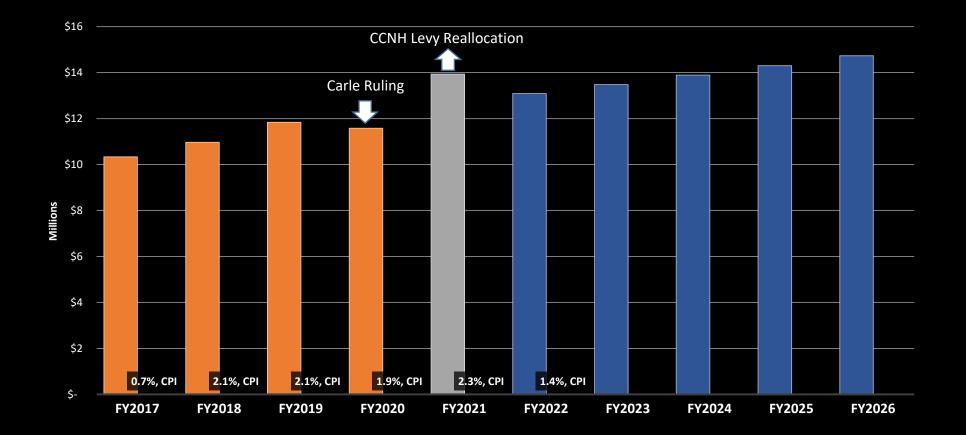






# Financial Challenges

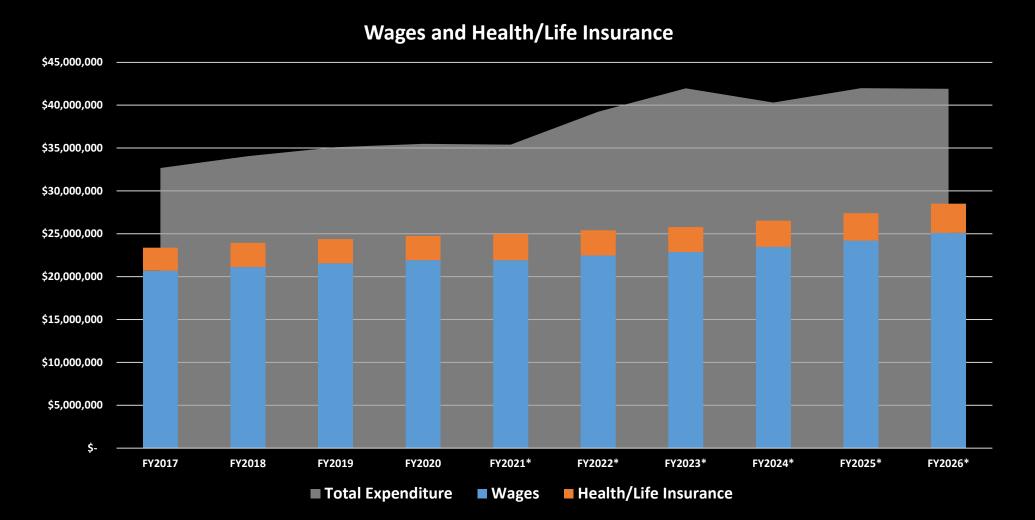
#### Personal Property Replacement Tax



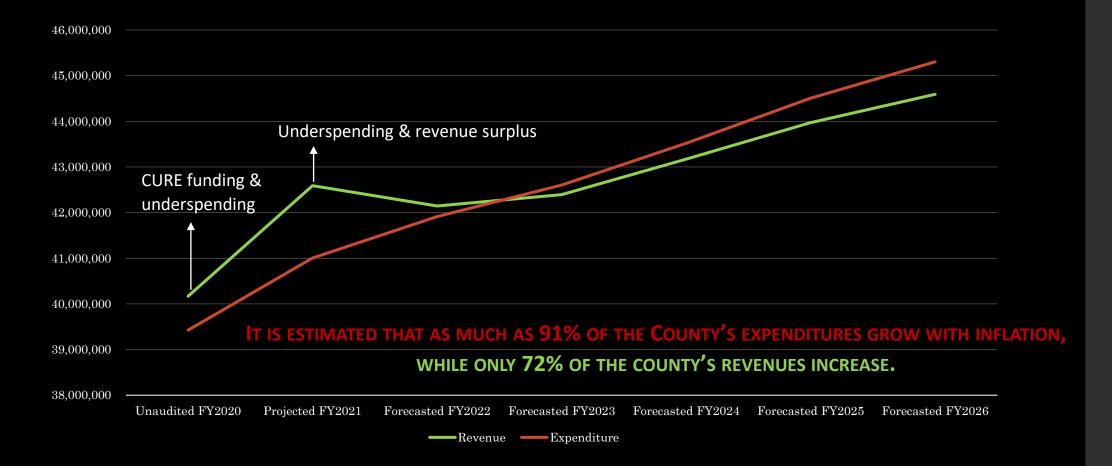

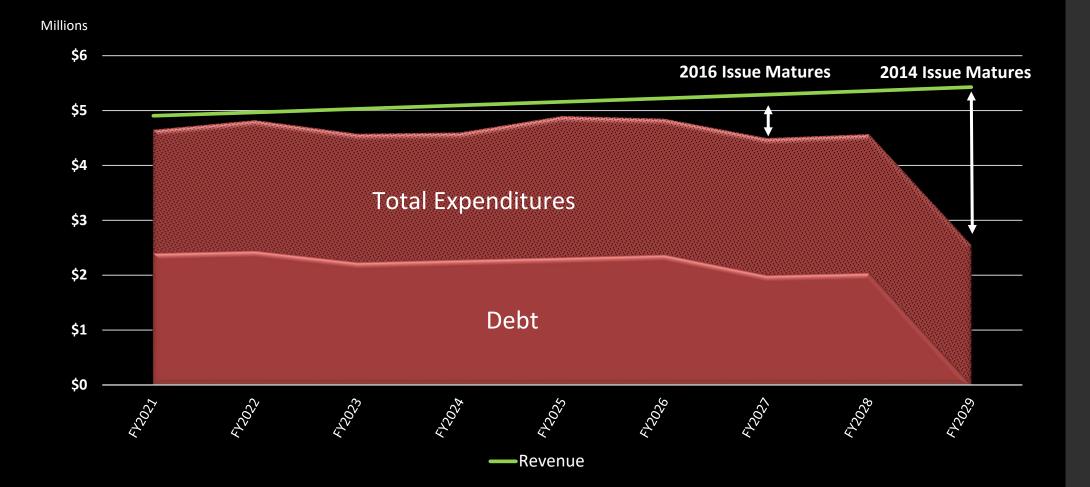
