3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, by receiving quotes for the improvements.

4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvement and shall show the division of cost between the County and the <u>Somer and Urbana</u> Road Districts.

5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Somer and Urbana</u> Road Districts.

6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.






