57 **VIII. National Association of County Engineers Executive Director, Kevan Stone-NACE Overview**

58 Mr. Blue said he has been honored to move through the ranks of the National Association of
59 County Engineers (NACE) the last several years. In April of this year, at the National Meeting in
60 Alabama, Mr. Blue was moved to the rank of President of the Association. Mr. Blue introduced
61 Mr. Kevan Stone, the Executive Director of the NACE. Mr. Stone congratulated Ms. Cowart and
62 gave a quick overview of NACE. Mr. Stone thanked the County Board members for allowing Mr.
63 Blue to serve the last several years. Mr. Stone offered his assistance to the County and said he
64 looks forward to working with Mr. Blue this year. Mr. Blue thanked Mr. Stone and said NACE is a
65 wonderful organization to be a part of and he looks forward to the year with Mr. Stone.

67 **IX. Petition Requesting and Resolution Approving Appropriation of Funds from the County Bridge
68 Fund, Rantoul-Stanton Township, Section #23-28130-00-BR**

69 Mr. Blue stated there is a bridge located on County Road 2400N between Section 4 in Stanton
70 Township and Section 32 in Rantoul Township that is in poor condition. The bridge deck
71 replacement is estimated to cost \$600,000. The townships are prepared to pay their equalized
72 share of 50% of the local cost for construction and 50% of the engineering.

74 Upon vote, the **MOTION CARRIED unanimously.**

76 **X. Petition Requesting and Resolution Approving Appropriation of Funds from the County Bridge
77 Fund, Ayers Township, Section #23-01131-00-BR**

78 Mr. Blue said there is a bridge located on County Road 400N between Sections 8 and 17 in Ayers
79 Township that is in poor condition. Ayers Road District is prepared to pay 50% of the local cost
80 for construction and 50% of the engineering costs associated with the replacement of the
81 structure. The estimated cost for replacement of the bridge deck is \$300,000.

92 prepared to pay 50% of the local cost for construction and 50% of the engineering costs.

100 Mr. Blue discussed a bridge located on County Road 3400N in Ludlow Township that is in poor
101 condition and needs replaced. The estimated cost of replacement is \$300,000. Ludlow
102 township is prepared to pay 50% of the local cost for construction and 50% of the engineering
103 costs associated with the bridge deck replacement.

110 which is in poor condition. The culvert is located between Section 34 in Somer Township and
111 Section 3 in Urbana Township on the township line. Each township is prepared to pay their
112 equalized share of 50% of the cost of replacement. The estimated cost to replace the culvert is
113 \$50,000.

130 the public. The letting is set for June 1, 2023.

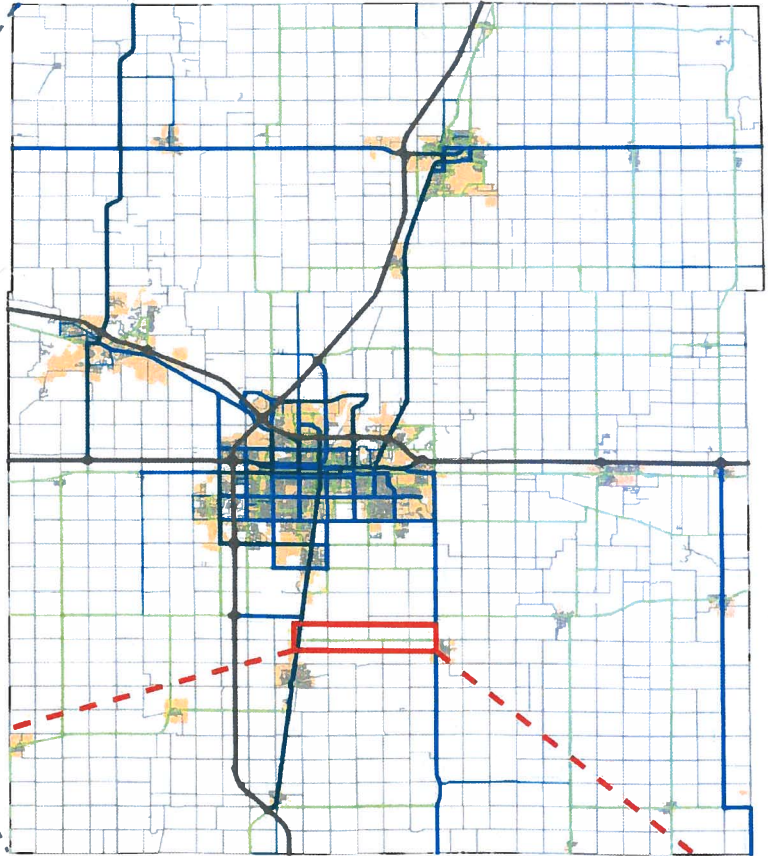

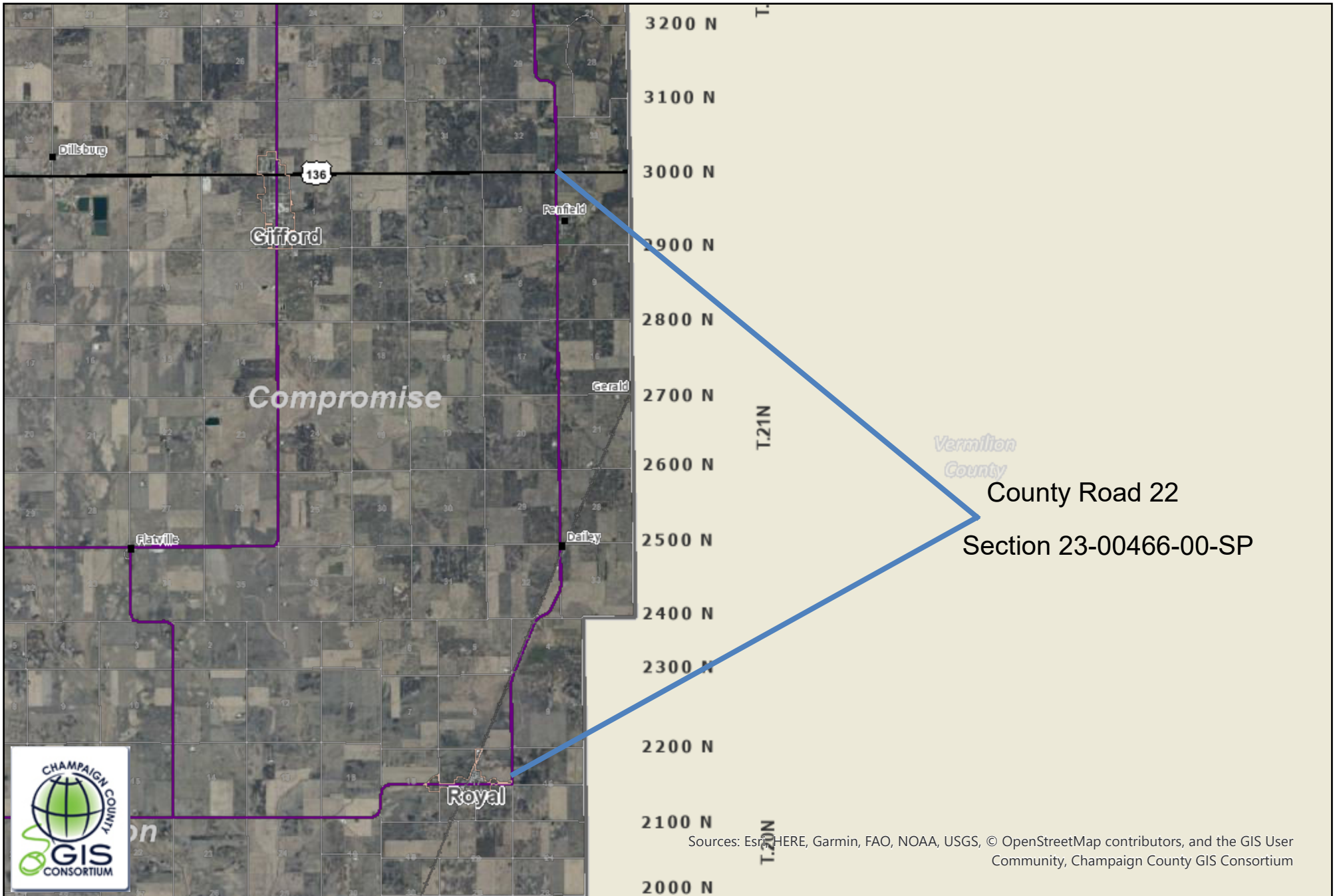

PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING
APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND
PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

PETITION

Petitioner, Josh Eisenmenger, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the Pesotum Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
2. There is a culvert located between sections 36 and 31 which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and
3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be replaced; and
4. The cost of replacing the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$22,400.00, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the Pesotum Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
5. The tax rate for road purposes in the Pesotum Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
6. The Pesotum Road District is prepared to pay one-half of the cost of the replacement of said structure.

Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvements and shall show the division of cost between the County and the Pesotum Road District.
5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the Pesotum Road District.
6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

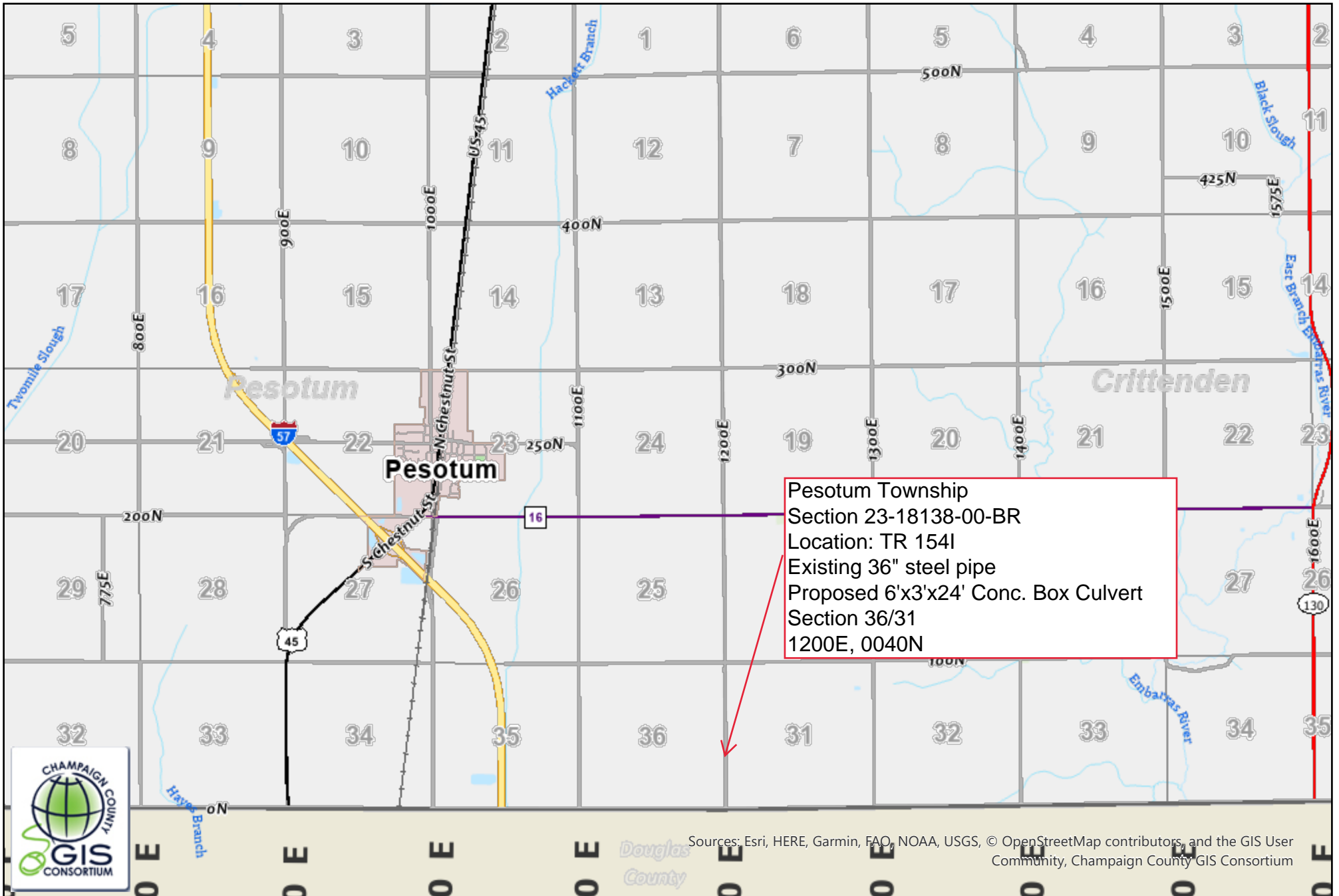

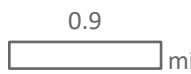
Tax Parcel Map
