The Champaign County Board of Health held a meeting on November 14, 2017 at the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District office, 201 W. Kenyon Road, Champaign. The meeting was called to order at 5:33 PM by President, Dr. Krista Jones.

Mr. David Thies was in attendance at 5:35 PM. Mr. Bradley Clemmons, County Board Liaison, Mr. David King, and Dr. Dorothy Vura-Weis were absent.

65 that it be considered as an outbreak response to cover costs. This item will be added to
66 the next meeting agenda.

68 Mr. Jim Roberts provided an update in regards to a complaint filed by the State's
69 Attorney for the water supply at 3051-C CR 1300 E in Rantoul. The abandoned well is
70 required to be sealed due to it containing water and debris following a fire. A court date
71 has been set for November 16, 2017.

74 review. Ms. Candi Crause gave an update on Hepatitis C.

87 Intergovernmental Agreement between the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District




