Networking Agreement between RACES (Rape Advocacy, Counseling, and Education Services), and Champaign County Sheriff's Office

RACES (Rape Advocacy, Counseling, and Education Services) and Champaign County Sheriff's Office acknowledge the following networking agreement, reflecting our shared commitment to ensuring quality and comprehensive services for survivors of sexual violence in our area.

Upon request, RACES will:

1. Provide advocacy services to survivors of sexual assault and abuse concerning criminal justice and medical procedures.
2. Exchange information within the boundaries of confidentiality, as defined by IL Rev. Stat. Ch. 110, Sec. 8-802.1; 735 ILCS 5/8-802.1.
3. Provide written materials to your organization to be distributed to survivors of sexual violence.
4. Maintain regular contact with your organization concerning services provided by RACES staff.
5. Work in a spirit of collaboration and cooperation with your organization.
6. Provide training on topics surrounding sexual violence to your organization.

The Champaign County Sheriff's Office will make reasonable efforts to:

1. Cooperate and work with RACES staff on behalf of survivors of sexual violence.
2. Inform sexual survivors and their significant others about services available through RACES.
3. Share information with RACES within the bounds of confidentiality laws.

Concerns raised by either party will be addressed in a timely manner. This agreement will remain in effect for one year unless cancelled at the written request of either party.
