WORKPLACE INJURY

The County will provide medical attention to any employee who experiences a work-related injury or illness and will make every attempt to accommodate employees who cannot perform their regular job because of temporary medical restrictions.

• WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM INJURED ON THE JOB?

- o If the injury is non-life threatening, <u>immediately report it to your Department Head/Supervisor</u> (not a co-worker)
- o Seek Medical Attention
- o Fill out County Injury Reports
- o Submit all Medical paperwork to Department Head/Supervisor
- Ask Questions
