The Champaign County Treasurer's Office made its fourth distribution of 2020 property taxes today. Over 111 million dollars was distributed to approximately 500 Champaign County taxing districts (2% still being held back to cover rejected payments, refunds, and returns).

The delay in processing the distribution for several days was to avoid causing over or under distribution caused by a file removed after the previous distribution. The deletion required software experts to recover the file and the Treasurer's office modified permissions to avoid this concern in the future. Additionally, the office received a huge influx of bank payments which are being processed over the next week. Barring any issues, delinquent notices will be sent to the impacted taxpayers beginning next week.
