4 Tuesday, May 22, 2012  
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6 **Call to Order**  
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8 The Champaign County Board of Health held a meeting on May 22, 2012  
9 at the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District office, 201 W. Kenyon Road,  
10 Champaign. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Secretary, Betty  
11 Segal.

13 **Roll Call**  
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15 Upon roll call, the following Board members were found to be present:  
16 Betty Segal, Secretary, Stan James, David Thies, Dr. Michael Ruffatto and Krista  
17 Jones. Bobbi Scholze, President, was absent. Dr. John Peterson, Treasurer, was  
18 in attendance at 5:40 PM.

20 Also present were Julie A. Pryde, CUPHD Administrator, Jim Roberts,  
21 CUPHD Director of Environmental Health, Amy Roberts, CUPHD, and Nancy  
22 Greenwalt, SmileHealthy Executive Director.

24 **Approval of Agenda/Addendum**  
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26 Stan James made a motion to approve the May 22, 2012 agenda. David  
27 Thies seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.  
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29 **Approval of Minutes**  
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31 Krista Jones made a motion to approve the March 27, 2012 meeting  
32 minutes. Stan James seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.  
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34 **Public Participation on Agenda Items Only**  
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36 There was no public participation regarding agenda items.  
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38 **Correspondence and Communications**  
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40 Julie A. Pryde noted that there was an article in the *News-Gazette*  
41 regarding Cherry Orchard Village apartments and that Eduardo Ramos will  
42 appear in court on April 26, 2012. Jim Roberts received a call for possible  
43 residence at Cherry Orchards.

45 **Smile Healthy**

47 David Thies made a motion to receive and place on file the following  
48 SmileHealthy monthly reports: March 2012 and April 2012. Dr. Michael Ruffatto  
49 seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.

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57 Stan James made a motion to approve the following CUPHD invoices:  
58 February 2012 services in the amount of \$55,116.07 and March 2012 services in  
59 the amount of \$59,485.43. Krista Jones seconded the motion. With all in favor,  
60 the motion carried.

62 Stan James made a motion to approve the Vector Surveillance and  
63 Control Grant between the Champaign County Public Health Department and  
64 Illinois Department of Public Health in the amount of \$21,962.00. David Thies  
65 seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.

67 Stan James made a motion to approve the following invoices for the  
68 State's Attorneys Office regarding the Ramos case: March in the amount of  
69 \$375.00 and April in the amount of \$75.00. Dr. Peterson seconded the motion.  
70 With all in favor, the motion carried.

72 Julie A. Pryde noted that the CUPHD Monthly Reports were available on-  
73 line. Dr. Peterson made a motion to accept CUPHD's Monthly Reports and place  
74 on file. Dr. Ruffatto seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.

76 **Old Business**

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78 Jim Roberts is waiting on corrections from Garrison Enterprises, Inc. for  
79 on-line food establishment inspection reporting.

80

81 Mr. Roberts attended the Conference of Food Protection; he was an  
82 observer. The FDA receives recommendations from shareholders on a variety of  
83 issues during this time. The Inspection Form Scoring Committee was unable to  
84 provide any results; there was no standardized model for inspection scoring  
85 developed by the committee. This committee has been disbanded. The FDA has  
86 funded additional research on the issue. Stan James requested that Mr. Roberts  
87 research surrounding counties for comparison of posting methods such as grade  
88 letters. Mr. Roberts would like to have the license and possibly inspection reports  
89 placed in a prominent place at food establishments; he will need leverage as to  
90 the determination and enforcement of the location. This will be an on-going item.

92 Mr. Roberts presented potential changes to Senate Bill 2867 changing the  
93 effective deadline for requiring NPDES permits for all surface discharges to the  
94 waters of the United States to "six months after the implementation of the USEPS  
95 General NPDES Permit". Stan James would like Mr. Roberts to meet with local  
96 town supervisors or to send a letter regarding the upcoming changes. This will be  
97 an on-going item.

103 Changes to the Illinois Water Well Construction Code need to be  
104 approved by the Illinois State Board of Health in June. This will be an on-going  
105 item.

107 **Other Business**

109 Stan James asked about having quarterly meetings. An amendment to the  
110 by-laws would be required and would need to be distributed to the Board two (2)  
111 weeks prior to the meeting at which the vote would take place. Suggested  
112 months are March, June, August (election of officers) and November. David  
113 Thies will work on an amendment.

115 Betty Segal noted the excellent service that a client reported to her that  
116 was given by Theresa Truelove at CUPHD.

118 **Public Participation on Non-Agenda Items Only**

120 Nancy Greenwalt of SmileHealthy reported that they will be known as  
121 Promise Healthcare, a community coalition housed in the current Frances Nelson  
122 building. The community health center will provide primary care services to the  
123 underserved population as well as expand care to new patients. This is an on-  
124 going process.
