25 Mr. Thies made a motion to approve the agenda. Dr. Vura-Weis seconded the

38 **Correspondence and Communications**

40 Ms. Julie Pryde reported that CUPHD Board of Health Chair, Mr. Andy
41 Quarnstrom, was elected as Chair for the National Association of Local Boards of
42 Health (NALBOH) and CUPHD was awarded the 2019 Health Department of the Year –
43 medium category.

45 Dr. Vura-Weis also reported that the Mental Health Board did not give an
46 increase in program allocation to the Crisis Nursery.

53 **Other Business**

55 Proposed County Board of Health Budget – Ms. Amanda Knight, Director of
56 Finance, gave the Board an overview of the proposed budget and allocations which
57 included \$15,000 for emergency services and \$10,000 for the continuation of
58 preventative services. Ms. Julie Pryde addressed the situation with Title X and the State
59 of Illinois not accepting the federal family-planning program funding. She stated that
60 CUPHD will continue to provide those services to clients. Ms. Tami Ogden, Deputy
61 County Administrator of Finance for Champaign County, addressed the Board regarding
62 the tax levys. The levy captures new growth revenue in the event of a favorable ruling in
63 the hospital property tax exemption case with an additional \$30,000 budgeted. The
64 Fund Balance reflects approximately \$33,000 of funds associated with TIF surplus
65 revenue thus showing the Fund Balance close to 50 percent. Per capita spending is due
66 to the expansion of grants.

68 Dr. Vura-Weis made a motion to move agenda item G3, approval of proposed
69 SmileHealthy Budget request for FY2020, to item G2. Dr. Kumar seconded the motion.
70 With all in favor, the motion carried.

71
72 Dr. Peterson made a motion to approve the proposed SmileHealthy Budget
73 request for FY2020 with an amendment to also approve the renewal agreement
74 between the Champaign County Board of Health and SmileHealthy. Mr. Thies seconded
75 the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.

76
77 Dr. Vura-Weis commented that a possible increase for inflation should be
78 considered next year. SmileHealthy will present a proposal for increased funding at the
79 March 2020 meeting.

81 Mr. David Thies made a motion to approve the proposed County Board of Health
82 Budget for FY2020. Dr. Kyle Fleming seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion
83 carried.






