6 **Call to Order**  
7

8 The Champaign County Board of Health held an electronic meeting via Zoom on  
9 May 18, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 5:34 PM by President, Dr. Krista  
10 Jones.  
11

12 **Roll Call**

14 Upon roll call, the following Board members were found to be present: Dr. Krista  
15 Jones, President, Mr. Bradley Clemmons, County Board Liaison, Mr. David Thies,  
16 Dr. Dorothy Vura-Weis, and Dr. Kyle Fleming. Ms. Cathy Emanuel was in attendance at  
17 6:03 PM, Dr. Julie Kumar, Vice President, was in attendance at 6:33 PM, and Dr. John  
18 Peterson, Secretary/Treasurer, was absent.

20 Also present: Ms. Julie Pryde, CUPHD Administrator, and Ms. Amanda Knight,  
21 CUPHD Director of Finance.

23 **Approval of Agenda/Addendum**  
24

25 Mr. David Thies made a motion to approve the agenda. Dr. Dottie Vura-Weis  
26 seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried.

28 **Public Participation on Agenda Items Only**  
29

30 Michelle Yarbrough, owner of Sun Singer Wine in Champaign, addressed the  
31 Board stating that she provided a proposed seating chart during a recent health  
32 inspection. Julie Pryde will follow up and stated that plans will be based upon sectors.  
33 Approximately 20 people were in attendance via Zoom for public participation.

35 **Correspondence and Communications**

37 Ms. Julie Pryde reported that a gym in St. Joseph was issued a cease and desist  
38 order. The State's Attorney issued a temporary restraining order and is looking at the  
39 next steps.

41 **CUPHD**  
42

43 Julie Pryde gave an update on COVID-19. Champaign County has 412 cases,  
44 8,609 tests have been performed, 188 people are actively in isolation and over 700 in  
45 quarantine, four people have been hospitalized, there have been seven deaths, there  
46 are 19 outbreaks, and 34 percent of all cases have occurred in the county, not within  
47 Champaign-Urbana. Infection control measures have been implemented at Rantoul  
48 Foods. A new testing site will open at Marketplace Shopping Center in Champaign

55 beginning Tuesday, May 19, 2020. The site will be open seven days a week from 8 a.m.  
56 to 4 p.m. Ms. Pryde also noted that CUPHD has hired new staff for language  
57 translation. The ultimate goal is to maintain hospital capacity; both hospitals currently  
58 have the needed capacity.  
59

60 Ms. Pryde responded to Dr. Jones' question regarding the need of additional  
61 funds for the COVID response stating that funding that has been allocated is currently  
62 sufficient. She also stated they she does not know what later this year will hold should  
63 there be a second wave.  
64

65 Ms. Pryde also answered questions from public participants including Cody  
66 Moody, Chris Miller and Brad Passalacqua regarding COVID-related topics and the re-  
67 opening of businesses in Champaign County. Jim Goss, Champaign County Board,  
68 gave comments in addition to COVID regarding the need for and the use of the fund  
69 balance.
