ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


NO. 90-1

WHEREAS, a normal condition of probation imposed by the Court in this county is that the defendant not leave the state without the permission of the Court; and whereas, the administrative burden of the court itself considering all such requests would be too great.

THEREFORE: Authority is hereby delegated to Court Services Officers to approve out-of-state travel by probationers without a court hearing unless directed otherwise by the sentencing judge. It is expected that in granting or denying such requests all Court Services Officers will give due consideration to the probationer's past compliance with all conditions of probation, especially in cases of non-essential travel. In all cases a written authorization will be presented to the prosecuting attorney, and to the sentencing judge for signature before the travel is to commence except when exigent circumstances make this impractical.

This order supercedes the previous Administrative Order on the same subject entered March 24, 1981.
