- 1. Probable cause hearings pursuant to <u>Gerstein v. Pugh</u>, 420 U.S. 103, 95 S.Ct. 854, 43 L.Ed. 2d 54 (1975), normally referred to as bond court;
- 2. Arraignment on all criminal charges;
- 3. Motions for reduction of bail;
- 4. Case management or scheduling hearings, and;

5. Rulings on motions and entry of orders and other matters where defendant's personal presence in the courtroom is not constitutionally required.
