County Administrative Order 2002-02

It appearing that the Supreme Court has provided by M.R. 15956 that Circuit Court Proceedings that may be recorded verbatim by a certified court reporter or by digital electronic recording equipment subject to the regulations promulgated by the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts and Order of the Court,

It further appearing that the Circuit Court in Champaign County has personnel who are trained and equipment in place to implement digital recordation,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Circuit Court proceedings are to be recorded verbatim by a certified court reporter or by digital electronic recording equipment installed in Champaign County subject to the regulations promulgated by the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts and the discretion and Orders of the Court.
2. Electronic Digital Recordings of proceedings shall remain under the control of the Court, with access to such recordings subject to regulations promulgated by the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts and such Orders as may be entered by the Court.
3. Electronic Digital Recordings of proceedings shall be accepted, and disseminated by transcripts prepared by Court Reporting Services Employees only. A certificate is to be signed and attached to the transcript by the Court Reporting Services Employees showing the foregoing to be a true and accurate transcript of the digital recorded proceedings.
