COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 06-02

The scheduling of hearings regarding judicial driving permits and or statutory summary suspensions will only be conducted through the Court Clerk assigned to the Traffic Court Judge. Notice of the filings associated with judicial driving permits or statutory summary suspension cases will be provided to the Court Clerk assigned to the Traffic Court Judge within twenty-four (24) hours of their receipt by the Clerk of the Circuit Court.

Counsel for the petitioning defendant must also deliver a courtesy copy of any filings regarding judicial driving permits and or statutory summary suspensions to the chambers of the Judge assigned to Traffic Court within forty-eight (48) hours of the date of filing.

In the case of a Petition for Judicial Driving Permit, a failure to comply with the protocol established in this Order will result in the Petition being stricken by the Court.

In the case of a Petition to Rescind Statutory Summary Suspension, a failure to comply with the protocol established in this Order will be deemed a waiver of the thirty-day (30) hearing requirement as set forth in 625 ILCS 5/2-118.1(b).

This Order is effective immediately.
