Juvenile Justice Initiative - Betsy Clarke

She also shared information about Redeploy Illinois. She spoke about efforts and programs that should be implemented to reduce the need for juvenile detention. Illinois Juvenile Justice Commission/DMC - Susan Witkin and Karima Douglas

Susan and Karima discussed their work to improve the juvenile justice system. Susan works with agencies and communities to improve data collection. She shared materials that help explain the

juvenile justice system and how it operates. Juvenile justice councils was one recommendation shared with the task force.

Karima discussed her work with other groups on the topic of race and the criminal justice system, especially how to effectively analyze data through the lens of race. She stressed how to think about and communicate the recommendations that we would like to make.
