SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM #1 June 29, 2023

Petitioner: Evergreen Cremation Services

Request:

Case 096-AM-23

Amend the Zoning Map to change the zoning district designation from the I-1 Light Industry Zoning District to the AG-2 Agriculture Zoning District in order to establish and operate the proposed Special Use in related Zoning Case 097-S-23.

Case 097-S-23

Authorize a Special Use to establish a crematory on land that is proposed to be rezoned to the AG-2 Agriculture Zoning District in related zoning case 096-AM-23, with the following waivers, on the subject property described below.

Waiver Part A: A lot area of 1.69 acres in lieu of the minimum required 10 acres for a crematory.

Waiver Part B: A setback of 72 feet from the street centerline of Tiffany Court in lieu of the minimum required 100 feet for a crematory.

Location: Lot 3 of Stahly Subdivision in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Champaign Township with an address of 314 Tiffany Court, Champaign.

Site Area: 1.69 acres

Time Schedule for Development: As soon as possible

STATUS

An article regarding the proposed crematory was published in the News Gazette on June 27, 2023 (Attachment B).

Attachment C is a request from a local resident requesting denial of the crematory Special Use Permit and related rezoning due to air quality concerns.

IEPA AIR PERMIT REQUIRED

Darwin Field, a representative of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency called in response to the News Gazette article about the proposed crematory. Darwin used to work in the IEPA Air Bureau and in that position, he received numerous complaints about local crematories. These were complaints mainly about pet and animal crematories.

Darwin explained that in his experience a crematory needs to have a "secondary chamber" maintained at 2200 degrees Fahrenheit and when the temperature drops below that it will produce black ash and that will result in complaints.

Darwin said that a crematory does require an IEPA Air Permit. A special condition has been added to ensure compliance.

PROPOSED SPECIAL CONDITIONS - NEW CONDITION ADDED

There is one special condition proposed for the Map Amendment:

A. Should a text amendment allowing a crematory in I-1 Light Industry Zoning District be approved in the future, the zoning for the subject property shall revert to the I-1 District.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That zoning for the subject property reflects the general intent of the Zoning Districts.

The following special conditions are proposed for the Special Use:

A. The Special Use is subject to the approval of Case 097-AM-23.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That it is consistent with the intent of the ordinance and the ZBA recommendation for Special Use.

B. The Zoning Administrator shall not issue a Zoning Compliance Certificate for the proposed construction until the petitioner has demonstrated that the proposed Special Use complies with the Illinois Accessibility Code.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That the proposed Special Use meets applicable State requirements for accessibility.

C. The Zoning Administrator shall not authorize a Zoning Compliance Certificate until the petitioner has demonstrated that any new or proposed exterior lighting on the subject property will comply with the lighting requirements of Section 6.1.2.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That the proposed uses are in compliance with the Zoning Ordinance.

D. The petitioners shall apply for a Change of Use Permit within 30 days of approval of Zoning Case 096-AM-23.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That the use complies with permitting requirements in the Zoning
Ordinance.

E. The petitioners shall provide documentation to the Zoning Administrator of the approved IEPA Air Permit prior to commercial use of the crematory.

The special condition stated above is required to ensure the following:

That air quality meets IEPA requirements.





To: Director John Hall and the Zoning and Planning Board for Champaign County, IL

Please do not allow a crematorium to be built at 314 Tiffany Court, Champaign II. That location is too close to several residential areas. There is also an elementary school a mile from the site and a future school to be built less than a mile from the site. There is already an outdoor sports complex for that school called The Field of Dreams. Since air quality is definitely an issue the Evergreen Place Assisted Living facility is only 0.3 miles from that location. These facilities include children and adults at risk for respiratory illnesses.

According to the National Institutes of Health "Crematoriums are sources of air pollution including mercury emission and may cause plausibly subtle chronic health effects due to long-term low-dose exposure." This is from an article from the National Library of Medicine, June 10,2020.

One last note, they are asking for variances that are way less than the required 10 acres and 100 foot setback. Please do not allow this facility to be built.
