As you are well aware severe weather has dominated the news and the activities of our agency this month. The storms on April 2nd and 3rd not only did damage through out the County but hit 2 County building one being our garage where our Command Post and other equipment are stored. The building sustained major damage however none of the equipment inside was damaged. At the present time Pro Ambulance is allowing us to store our Command Post in their facility. We are working with the Physical Plant people, Insurance Adjusters, and Contractors to determine the if the building can be repaired or replaced. We have worked with almost all town and villages to complete Damage Reports to the State. Champaign County received a State Disaster Declaration but no State resources were needed to resolve any issues.

We worked with the State to complete an onsite inventory of all the equipment purchased through Homeland Security and our office for First Responder agencies, all equipment was verified to be in place as the grant required.
