Summary

The monthly IEMA and local emergency radio tests were conducted. Siren tests were not conducted due to the extreme weather and temperatures. The EMA liaison met this month for January, Gifford lessons-learned were discussed. EMA attended the monthly Fire Chief's Association meeting. EMA opened the Emergency Operations Center for the snow storm January 5 and 6 (32 hour operation). EMA kept responders, local ESDA's, community leaders and the public informed prior to, during and after the storm and through the month for extreme temperatures on emergency information, road conditions, warming centers, shelters, and National Weather Service updates. Also, EMA hosted a meeting about lesson learned from the snow storm with local agencies to improve emergency operations for future events. EMA initiated a meeting with IDOT Region 7 personnel to improve communications between agencies, resulting in improved procedures and notifications for emergency situations concerning our area of operations.
