Summary

The monthly IEMA and local emergency radio tests were conducted. The monthly siren test was conducted due to severe weather. The agency hosted the EMA liaison meeting for the month of September. The agency posted articles and other information on social media outlets for severe weather preparedness to include road closure, weather information, seasonal topics as well as other emergency management related information. We continue to get more followers on EMA twitter and friends on EMA Facebook accounts. CCEMA attended the monthly Fire Chief's meeting. The office continues to work the grant funded emergency accountability equipment and software for the accountability of personnel and resources specifically for disasters and events, over 800 IDs produced for various responder agencies. On 31 October CCEMA assisted the CPD by providing E-1 for use during a barricade situation.
