MOTION: Ms. Dill moved to approve the minutes from the April 3, 2007 Board meeting. Ms. Jordan seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Claims:

A copy of the claims report was included in the Board packet.

MOTION: Ms. Jordan moved to accept the claims report as presented. Ms. Dill seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Funding Application Recommendations for FY08:

A decision memorandum with staff funding recommendations was included in the packet. Staff recommendations were organized into "tiers" intended to prioritize available funds against applications that matched up well against criteria and defined CCDDB priorities. Tier One is an endorsement of the efficacy and productivity of all incumbent programs. Tier Two is an enthusiastic endorsement of new initiatives contingent on their moving forward in PY08. Tier Three is an endorsement of some program expansion/development initiatives along with recognition of the advancing costs associated with programs favored either by the coherence of

their applications and/or criteria match up. Tier Four is a guarded endorsement of new program initiatives or guarded recognition of advancing costs. Tier Five comprises programs or amounts requested but not funded.

> MOTION: Ms. Jordan moved to accept staff recommendations for each program to fund Tier One and Tier Three for Champaign County Advocacy and Mentoring Resources (CCAMR). Ms. Dill seconded. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Developmental Services Center – Family Development Center/Children's Services</u> Recommend: Tier One \$440,000 Tier Four \$11,000 Tier Five \$17,600

<u>Developmental Services Center – Family Development Center- SEL Day Care Consult</u> Recommend: Tier Two \$25,000 Tier Five \$25,000

<u>Developmental Services Center – Developmental Training – Rantoul Expansion</u> Recommend: Tier One \$556,307 Tier Three \$13,908 Tier Four \$13,908 Tier Five \$8,353

<u>Developmental Services Center – Individual and Family Support</u> Recommend: Tier One \$350,500 Tier Three \$17,525 Tier Five \$5,258

<u>Developmental Services Center – Respite Program</u> Recommend: Tier One \$75,000 Tier Three \$3,750 Tier Five \$1,125

<u>Persons Assuming Control of Their Environment (PACE) – Independent Living Coordination – Champaign County</u> Recommend: Tier One \$39,000 Tier Three \$1,950 Tier Four \$17,500 Tier Five \$17,750

> MOTION: Ms. Jordan moved to accept staff recommendations for all Tiers for Persons Assuming Control of Their Environment (PACE). Ms. Dill seconded. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Regional Planning Commission – Champaign County Head Start</u> Recommend: Tier One \$9,892 Tier Three \$5,245 Tier Four 5,245.

> MOTION: Ms. Dill moved to accept staff recommendations for all Tiers for Regional Planning Commission—Champaign County Head Start.Ms. Jordan seconded. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Developmental Disabilities Fair Recommend: Tier Two \$5,000
